Where is Afghan Wireless based?

Founded in 1998, it is based in Kabul, Afghanistan with various regional offices. Headquartered in Kabul, Afghan Wireless provides 4G LTE and other services, such as internet and mobile payments to about five million subscribers across Afghanistan's 34 provinces.

When was the first telephone network established in Afghanistan?

The Ministry of Communication in Afghanistan was established in 1955. However, the first electronic communication equipment, i.e. one to one wired telephone network in Afghanistan was connected to the presidential Place in 1898. However, that one line network was replaced by a small telephone exchange with the capacity of 25 lines in 1908.

What is the international calling code for Afghanistan?

The international calling code for Afghanistan is +93. The following is a partial list of mobile phone companies in the country: All the companies providing communication services are obligated to deliver 2.5% of their income to the communication development fund annually.

How many radio stations are there in Afghanistan?

Radio broadcasting in Afghanistan began in 1925 with Radio Kabul being the first station. The country currently has over 200 AM, FM and shortwave radio stations. They broadcast in Dari, Pashto, English, Uzbeki and a number of other languages.
