



How to determine the base station site coordinates

Overview

A convenient way to obtain a reliable reference position for the base receiver is by setting up the base station antenna above a known reference point such as a geodetic control point or survey marker. With the use of a tribrach and tripod this can be done very accurately.

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For an RTK survey, the base station coordinates must be Global coordinates, that is the coordinates must be in the Global reference datum at the Global reference epoch. The Global reference datum and the Global reference epoch are shown in the Select coordinate system screen of the job properties.

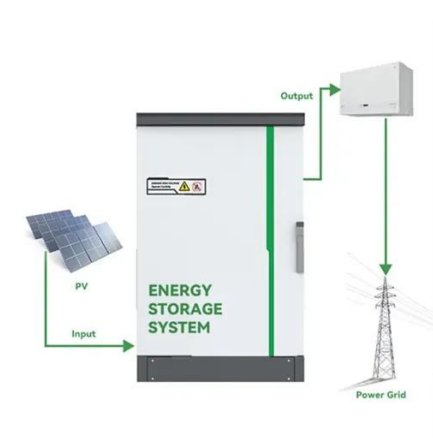
