Overview

What voltage is used in Maldives?

In Maldives, power plugs and sockets (outlets) of type D and type G are used. The standard voltage is 230 V at a frequency of 50 Hz. The Maldives is a tropical nation in the Indian Ocean, known for its beautiful beaches, luxurious resorts, and crystal-clear waters.

How much electricity does the Maldives use?

The Maldives uses 230 volts and 50Hz electricity, the same as many European countries. If your electronics are designed for 110-120 volts and 60Hz, you will need a voltage converter and possibly a transformer. Check the voltage requirements on your devices and use a voltage converter if necessary.

Can I use a power adapter in the Maldives?

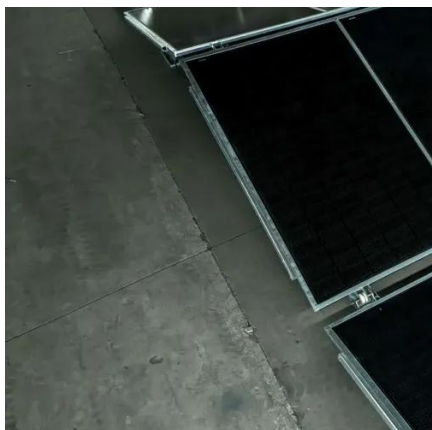

If you are traveling to the Maldives with electronic devices from a country with a different voltage or frequency, you will need to use a power adapter and possibly a voltage converter to ensure safe and proper operation of your devices.

Can I use a 220V 240V outlet in Maldives?

Adapting for Voltage: If your device operates on 220V-240V, it's compatible with Maldives' outlets. For devices that run on 110V, a voltage converter or transformer is necessary to prevent damage. **What You Need:** Before your trip, check your device's voltage compatibility to avoid any inconvenience.

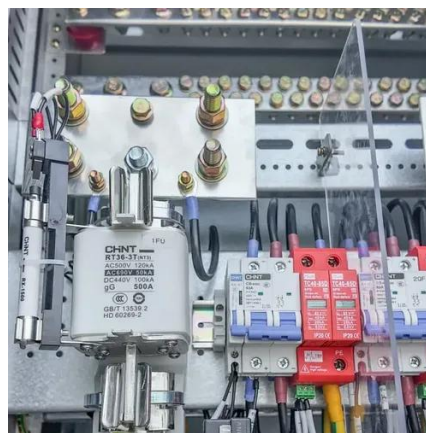

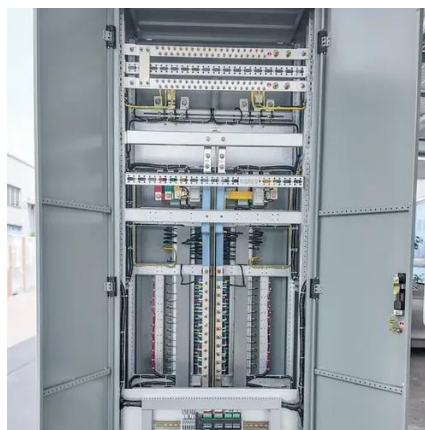

Medium Voltage or MV: any voltage from 1 kV up to 35 kV that is normalized and approved by the MEA for its use in power distribution in the Republic of Maldives.

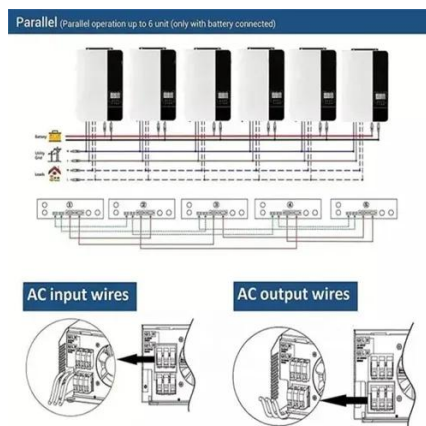
