



Ottawa battery for energy storage





Overview

BESS is an emerging technology using batteries and associated equipment to store excess energy from the electrical grid, which can then discharge energy in periods of high demand. They are used to provide backup power to individual sites as well as to support the provincial grid.

In 2025, the City of Ottawa established official plan and zoning provisions for battery energy storage uses in accordance with new Official Plan policy. Changes have been made to the city's Official Plan and zoning bylaws to create a building for storing electricity in off-peak hours from the grid. The City of Ottawa's Agriculture and Rural Affairs Committee approved the changes for Battery Energy Storage Systems (BESS), set to guide the land use.

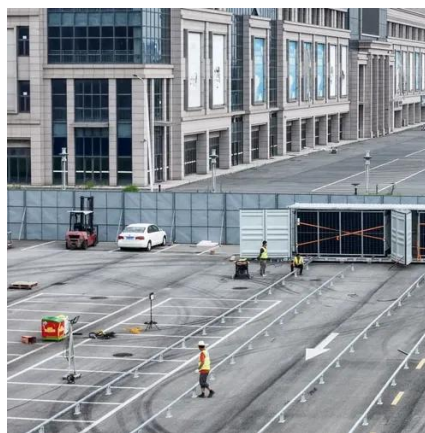
